The German-Israeli Research Consortium ”Migration and Societal Integration” is organizing an international fall school which will provide doctoral and post-doc students with training from experienced researchers in the field of migration and integration. Students will be offered lectures, study groups and discussions about major concepts, methods and findings of migration research. Students will also receive advice concerning their own research project. In addition, our training offers the opportunity to interact with students from other cultures working in the same research field.

Invited teachers among others are Andrew J. Fuligni (University of California, Los Angeles), Fons J.R. van de Vijver (University of Tilburg, The Netherlands), Karen Phalet (Utrecht University, The Netherlands), Carol Pfaff (Free University Berlin, Germany) and Wassilis Kassis (University of Basle, Switzerland).

The Fall School is funded by the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF). Participation fee is 100 Euro. Expenses for travel (most cost-effective transportation), accommodation and meals for the entire week will be covered.

The participation conditions are as follows:

- Doctoral Student or Post-doc in Sociology, Psychology or related discipline
- University Affiliation
- Currently involved in a research project on migration and integration
- Fluent English (speaking and reading)

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including list of publications
Eventual former participation to any other summer school
- Summary of the (doctoral) research project in the field of migration
- Reference letter from the professor supervising the thesis project or current project
